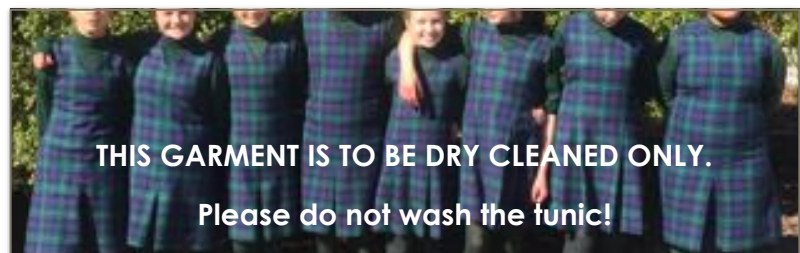

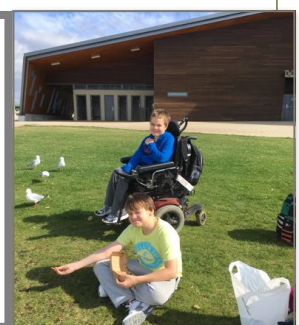
### A VERY SPECIAL EASTER
