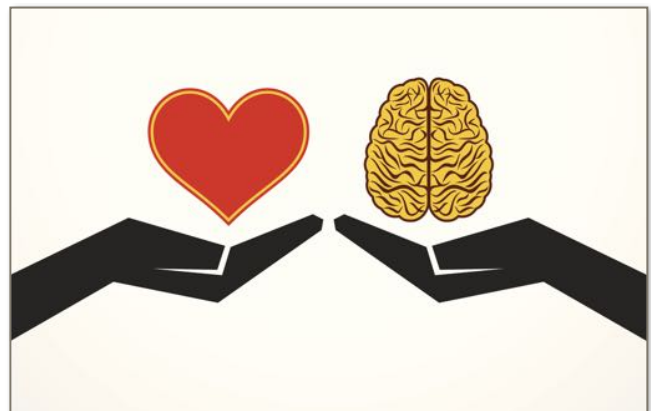

GUARD YOUR HEARTS & MINDS!

The gaming industry is changing rapidly and its no longer just violent content that's concerning. As online multiplayer and chat functionality is becoming the new norm in modern games, its impossible to know who your children are playing and chatting with and what the stranger might be saying over the internet. Brett Lee, a former Victorian policeman has put together a downloadable handbook for parents, caregivers and teachers. It covers new business models, gaming addiction, online multiplayer worries and more. Parents, we suggest strongly that you take the time to read this material and share around to anyone who is interested. The handbook (copies available at the school office or via the link below) runs through everything you need to know to ensure the children in your care are safe while gaming. It takes a look at some of the risks your children could be exposed to while gaming, the early warning signs that something may be wrong and what to do if you identify a problem. We are living in a culture that depends highly on technology, and if used correctly can enhance and improve lives, HOWEVER, if used incorrectly it can damage and destroy lives forever!! The Bible tells us in Philippians 4:8 to "keep our thoughts continually fixed on all that is authentic and real, honourable and admirable, beautiful and respectful, pure and holy, merciful and kind." We **need** to instil this type of behaviour into our kids
