### THIS WEEK IN ASSEMBLY

We talked about the Golden Rule in assembly this week. "Do unto others as you would wish them to do unto you." In the Bible it is found in the amazing Sermon on the Mount given by Jesus in Matt 7:12.

It is interesting to note how many world religions have a version of it. What is interesting is that the Bible version is in the positive: "**Do** unto others..." whereas others are negative: "**Do not** do..." In the Good Samaritan story (Luke 10) it's not enough for us to just look at the half dead traveller on the road, we have to **do** something positive about it. The robbers did wrong, the Levite priest did nothing. They all broke the Golden Rule. It was left to the Samaritan, the foreigner, to show us the right way.
