Ananias and Saphira were not truthful and they were struck dead for what most people would view as a little matter. They told a lie. They didn't think it was a lie that would hurt or disadvantaged anybody. Ananias and Saphira wanted to gain a reputation for being generous, but they didn't tell the whole truth and made themselves out to be more generous than they really were. They actually made a trap for themselves and then they were caught in it. (Acts 5)

Why do people lie? Sometimes they lie to avoid punishment, to protect their reputation, to impress others or to get something they want. The Bible clearly tells us "be sure your sin will find you out". This means your lies will eventually catch up with you, like Ananias & Saphira. We can be certain of this, that even though others may not know we have lied, God always knows and always sees. In John 8:32 we read that "the truth will set you free", so tell the truth...always!
