CROSS COUNTRY

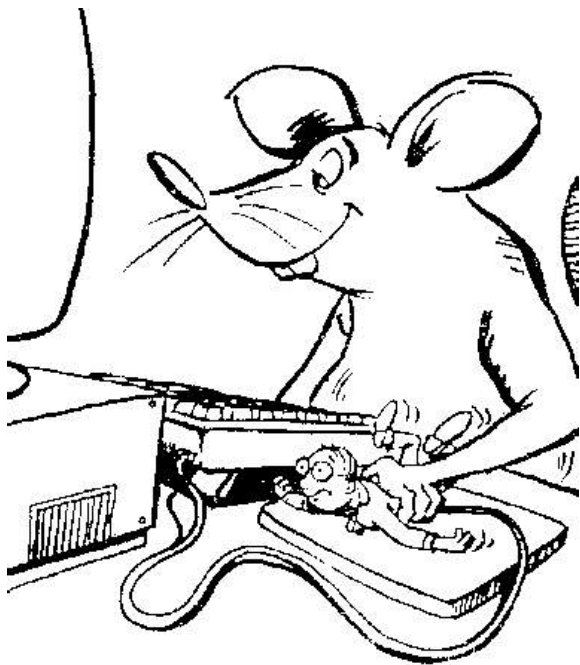
