**Where:** Campbell Town Football Oval, on the main street near the swimming pool.

**Time:** 11:00am registration and directions, with 11.30am sharp start!!

**Who:** All our students will be leaving school at 9.00 am and returning in the afternoon, bus times will be slightly later than normal by 20 minutes in the afternoon. We will be competing against students from other ACE schools and ACE Home Schoolers.

**What to Wear:** Full sports uniform is required at all times by runners and spectators. Entrants are to run in sports shorts and tshirts and keep track suits for putting on afterwards.

**Cost:** The school is covering the cost for all students.

**Student Identification/Registration:** Registration and identification labels will be completed and given out on the day.

**Lunch:** The Campbell Town Football Club Committee have kindly offered to run a canteen for us on the day. Items will include pies, pasties, sausage rolls, savs, hot chips & home made soup, tea & coffee, plus assorted drinks, bars, chips & ice creams. There is no need to order before hand just bring your money on the day.

**Facilities:** there will be showers and toilets available for runners, plus undercover areas if the weather is wet for spectators. We do suggest that you come prepared with a coat and suitable footwear, umbrella and a blanket.

**Parents, friends and relatives are most welcome to attend.**

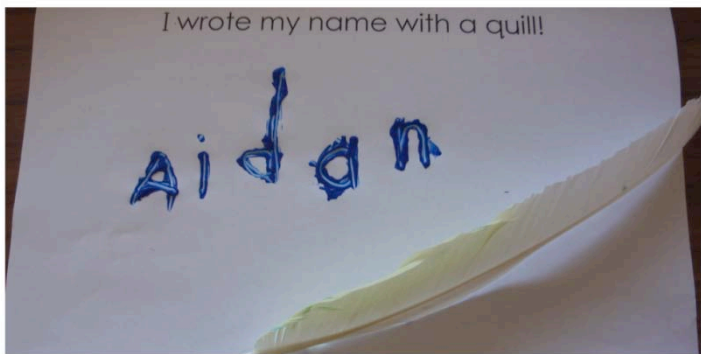
## GENEVA RECIPE BOOK
