STUDENT CONVENTION

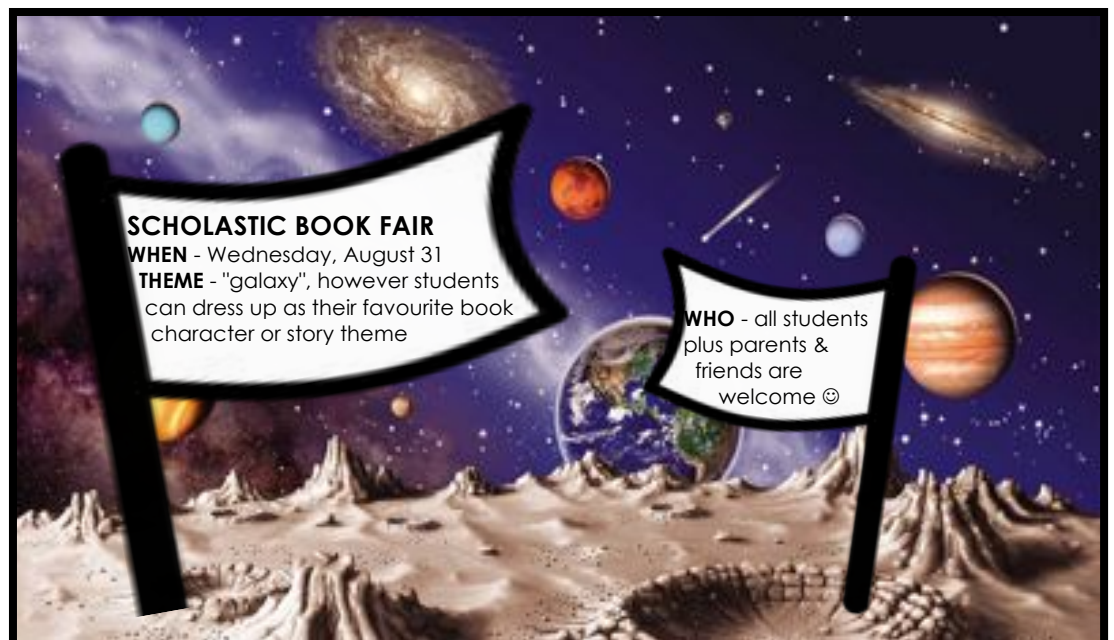
