## BURNIE SHOW

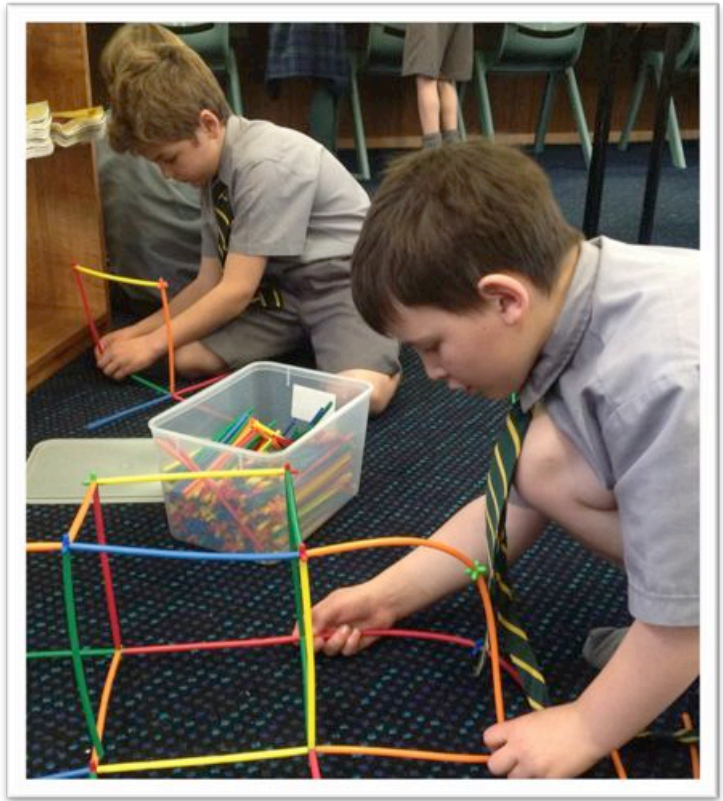

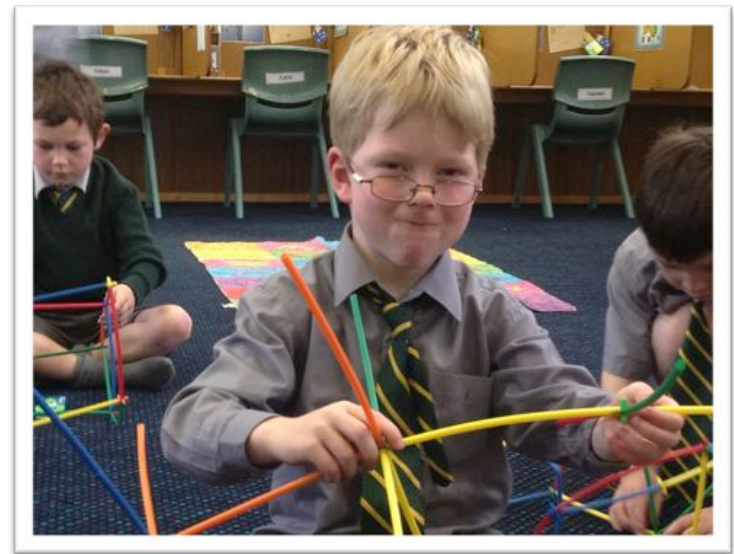
