**\$500 HELP FOR SCHOOL COSTS**

Is your child starting school next year? Would \$500 help with education costs? The Smith Family is managing a Saver Plus fund established by ANZ Bank and the Brotherhood of St Laurence. Saver Plus is a financial literacy program that has a matched savings component. Participants save \$500 over 10 months and then ANZ matches their savings with another \$500, which is to be spent on educational expenses for the participant themselves or their child/children. Eligible educational costs include school uniform, textbooks, computers, laptops and tablets, excursions and camps, sports equipment and lessons, music tuition and instrument hire. Further, The Smith Family is also offering \$500, matched dollar for dollar, for TAFE, traineeship or apprenticeship costs, including course fees and tutors, computers, text books, trade tools and furniture for studying. You may be eligible for either fund if you have a Health Care or Pension Card.
