BAD NEWS, GOOD NEWS

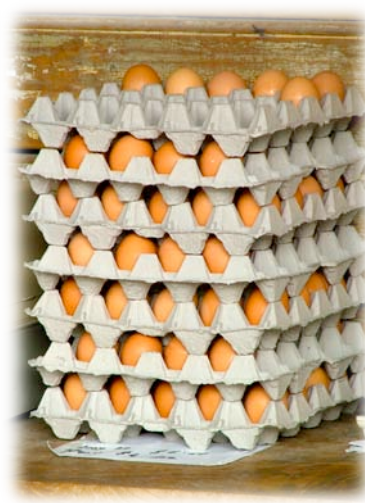
