Through all of this, we have been experimenting with supermarket bought flour and our own home-made starter/yeast that we had prepared a year ago. This was so that we could be ready for our own home-grown flour. We then got it all threshed ready for this term. We milled the grain with a hand-mill and made a loaf each. This week we made loaves to put into the Devonport Show in the Bread competition.
