

Smashed pea and goat's cheese rolls:

Whats inside:

200g frozen peas

1 clove garlic, finely crushed

1/4 cup fresh mint

2 tsp extra virgin olive oil

1 tsp red wine vinegar

10 bread rolls (of your choice)

100g goat cheese

2 sprigs fresh thyme (or other fresh herbs)

Method:

Step 1

Place the peas in a saucepan of boiling water, and cook fo 3-5 minutes or until tender. Cool under a cold running tap and drain.

Step 2

Pop the peas into the food processor (or use a hand blender) and puree together with garlic, mint, olive oil and vinegar, until the mixture looks like a rustic paste.

Step 3

Spoon pea mixture into rolls and top with as much goat cheese as you like. Add a sprinkle of herbs and season with salt and pepper.

Easy Turkey Roll-ups:

Whats inside:

2 cups of strawberries, washed and sliced2 tbs chia seeds or hemp seeds1/2 lemon, juiced

Method:

Step 1

Place strawberries, lemon juice and seeds into a high speed blender and puree. Pour onto baking tray and evenly smooth out to make a thin layer.

Step 2

Cook in the oven for 3 hours. Once cooked, transfer to a wire rack and allow to cool until firm.

Step 3

Slice into pieces and store in an airtight container
